Deed of Bargain and Sale from Benjamin Brode and Elizabeth his wife to John Barrett conveying a tract of 35 acres of land was proved in the Clerks Office on the 21st September 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the Office on the 17th of August 1840 by two other witnesses thereto was together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Norton Taylor executors of James Taylor dec'd to Martha Taylor conveying a tract of 116 1/3 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 22nd day of September 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Richard Blackstone of the first part Godwin Griffen of the second part and Benjamin Griffen of the third part Conveying their head of heirs was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 21st day of September 1840 by Benjamin Griffen and proved in the Office on the same day by the witness thereto as to the other two parties and admitted to record.

Deed of partition between John Boyton of the first part, James Turner of the second part and Billed Syms of the third part making partition of the land which descended to the heirs of Solomon Turner dec'd was proved in the Clerks Office on the 19th of October 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the Office on the 21st day of September 1840 by two other witnesses thereto was admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from John J. Mason to Richard & William conveying a tract of 70 acres of land was returned to the Office on the 19th day of October 1840 and together with the certificate annexed admitted to Record.
