Deed of Bargain and Sale from Richard Darden to James C. Crockett conveying a house and Lot situate in the Town of Jerusalem was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 21st September 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between James C. Crockett of the first part, Littleton R. Edwards of the second part and Richard Darden of the third part conveying a house and Lot in the Town of Jerusalem was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 21st September 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Oliver Crockett and Elizabeth his wife and Benjamin Crockett to Arrington Darden conveying their interest in 75 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 22nd September 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the Office on the 21st day of September 1840, by two other witnesses thereto was together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Benjamin Brode and Elizabeth his wife to John Barrett conveying a tract of 35 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 21st September 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the Office on the 17th of August 1840 by two other witnesses thereto was together with the certificate of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Robert Taylor executor of James Taylor dec'd to Martha Taylor conveying a tract of 116 2/3 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 22nd day of September 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Richard Blackthorn of the first part, Gordon Whiffin of the second part and Benjamin Whiffin of the third part, conveying seven head of hogs was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 21st day of September 1840 by Benjamin Whiffin and proved in the Office on the same day by the witnesses thereto as to the other two parties and admitted to record.

Deed of partition between John Doyles of the first part, James Turner of the second part and Robert Tyms of the third part making partition of the land which descended to the heirs of John Doyles dec'd was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 19th of October 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the Office on the 21st day of September 1840 by two other witnesses thereto, was admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from John McKason to Richard A. Gillman conveying a tract of 710 acres of land was returned to the Office on the 19th day of October 1840 and together with the certificate annexed admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Benjamin E. Cobb to William H. Nicholson conveying a
