

In Additional account of Benjamin Griffins administration on Elizabeth Sammons's estate was returned and ordered to be set out for exceptions.

In account of Beccwell Murfes guardianship of Rester, Mary, William and John Morgan was returned and ordered to be resubmitted from file.

Alfred T. Griffiths is appointed Receiver in account No. 33 on behalf of Richard A. Kelly et al.

In account of James Gray's guardianship of James M. Howell was returned and ordered to be resubmitted.

In account of Josiah Holloman's executors proceedings on Gardner Johnson's estate was returned and ordered to be set out for exceptions.

James H. Stubbs who hath been duly licensed to practice the law in the Courts of this Commonwealth or his motion has leave to practice in this Court, and thereupon he took the oath of fidelity to the Commonwealth and the oath of an attorney at law.

Ordered that James Riley toll render before master Commissioner Cobb an account of Elias Sammons's guardianship of Willis Ely, and that the said Commissioner examine him and settle the same and make report thereof to Court with any motions specially stated demands pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Mary A. Jelks orphan of Benjamin Jelks deceased with the approbation of the Court made choice of William P. Harvey to her guardian who together with Hinshaw Jelks and Ingacio E. Jelks his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to law.

On the motion of Edmund Newson who made oath and together with John W. Miller and George A. W. Newson his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of fifteen hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs. Certificate is granted him for issuing of letters of administration on the estate of Mary C. Newson deceased in due form.

Ordered that Henry Esthury, Solomon D. Parker, Nathan Dunn and Edward Nichols any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose do I promise all the personal estate of Mary C. Newson deceased and return the same to me in their hands to Court.

George H. Gardner is appointed Constable in the town of Wethersfield in the room of Thomas Lawrence resigned it appearing to the Court that the said Gardner is a man of honest, sober and good behavior and thereupon he took the several oaths required by law and Ingacio E. Jelks and Lemuel R. Gardner his securities entered into a bond according to law, which bond was acknowledged by the officers therein named and ordered to be recorded.
