The Commissioner appointed by the interlocutory decree made in this cause at August Term last to make sale of the land wherein situated this Leg made a report which is in these words to wit: "In conformity to the annual decree, the undersigned did (after duly advertising the same) sell on the 24th day of September 1840 to the highest bidder the tract of land mentioned in said decree and James H. Love became the purchaser thereof for the sum of One hundred and twenty six dollars. The costs and expenses attending the same is thirteen dollars and thirty eight cents deducted from the amount of sales leaves the sum of one hundred and seven dollars sixty two cents. This sum divided into four equal parts make \$32.50 each, for which amount I have taken James H. Love, except for retaining one half the amount sales. The other half I have divided into four equal parts making the sum of \$13.45 $\frac{1}{4}$ cents, each of the other legatees parts and have taken from the said James H. Love with John Vick his security, four bonds of equal amounts, one payable to Melly Scutchins, heir of Adam Scutchins, one other bond payable to Mary Scutchins, one other bond payable to Betsy Scutchins, and one other bond payable to William Scutchins. The two former bonds paid over to the parties and the last latter deposited in the Clerks Office as by the decree I am directed. All of which acts and doings is respectfully submitted to the Court. Given under my hand this 24th day of September 1840. Benj Griffin Esq.
And it is ordered that the said report be continued for one term.

An Inventory and Appraisement of the slaves belonging to the heirs of John Headard dec^d was returned and ordered to be recorded.

The Court doth agree William L. Rocke, guardian to Mary F. and Martha E. Rocke orphans of Nathaniel Rocke dec^d and therefore the said William L. Rocke with Henry Lovelace and Edward Beaton his witnesses entered into and acknowledged a bond in the sum of five thousand dollars conditioned according to law.
