Upon the petition of James Turner, Patsy Williams, Sally Williams and Selma Williams descendants of a female of the Nottoway Tribe of Indians. It appearing that the Trustees of the said Tribe of Indians have had due notice of this petition. It is ordered that the Trustees do advise and set apart to the petitioners their proportion of the estate, real and personal held in trust for the benefit of the said Tribe and make report thereof to Court. It appearing to the Court that the petitioners are not likely to become chargeable to any part of the Commonwealth.

The Court certifies that William L Swaley who wishes to obtain a license to practice the law in the Courts of this Commonwealth has resided in this County for the last preceding twelve months, that he is a person of honest demeanor and upwards of twenty one years of age.

On motion of Thomas Doyal. Ordered that James Holmes, Patrick Rorer and James Williams being sworn before a Justice of the peace do view the way proposed by said Doyal for altering a road as well as the present way and report to the Court the comparative conveniences and inconveniences that will result as well to individuals as to the public of such alterations to be made as is proposed.

And as the warrant of the said Samuel Revell has been allowed to give bond himself to be bound in the sum of One hundred dollars with two sureties to be bound in the sum of fifty dollars each. And thereupon the said Samuel Revell with James F French & Bennett D Whitfield his securities there in Court acknowledged themselves to be indebted unto Thomas W Holmes Governor of this Commonwealth the said Revell in the sum of One hundred dollars and the said Securities in the sum of fifty dollars each of their respective goods and chattels, lands and Tenements to be bound and to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Not upon this condition that if the said Samuel Revell shall make his personal appearance before the Justices of the County Court to be held at the Courthouse on the first day of the next Term of the said Court to answer the Commonwealth of the felonious offense aforesaid of which he stands charged then the above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force.
