

6 Part hereof said Ruffin - And that the slaves of which said Ruffin did propose to divide into three parts as near as may be, and that one third be allotted to the master who is now or in the slaves, and the other two thirds be assigned to the guardian of Almonia A. and Georgina Hart. But the plaintiff are not to have the benefit of this decree, until they or someone for them shall interate responding bonds with sufficient security according to law - that James & Little, Slingers Lane and Soper Carroll be appointed to carry this decree into effect, who will make report to Court in order to a final decree.
