

At a Court Summons and held at the Courthouse of Franklin's County on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of December 1848, for the examination of Matthew Drake charged with the murder of James Scott, a free Painter, Sarah C. Porter, Lydia Hinge, a free woman of colour & Seth Mingo a coloured infant at the house of the aforesaid Scott in this County.

Present James D. Maynard, James Maynard, William A. Sparks, Edwin W. Blood and William H. Nicholson. Test.

The Court being thus constituted the said Matthew Drake was set to the bar in custody of the keeper of the jail of this County and thereupon Summons witnesses to wit. Sige Drury, Charles Bull and James C. Jones were sworn and examined and the forenamed heard in his defense by counsel. On consideration whereof it is the opinion of the Court that the said Matthew Drake ought to be tried for the offence aforesaid of which he stands charged at the next Session Superior Court of Law and Sessions for this County. And therefore he is remanded to jail.
