Deed of bargain and Sale from Elizabeth Daugherty to Elizabeth Drake conveying her life right in a tract of 113 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 21st of December 1840 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the Clerk's Office on the 28th of May 1835 by two other witnesses, was admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and Sale from James & Mary Leitch Ellsworth and John Drury to Elizabeth Reebell conveying a tract of 31 1/2 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 21st of December 1840 by James Mayger and having been before acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 16th of November 1840 by Leitch Ellsworth and on the 19th of May 1840 by John Drury, was admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and Sale from John A. Hall and Mary A. his wife to a trustee David conveying a tract of 28 1/2 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 21st of December 1840 by John A. Hall and together with the certificate issued of the foregoing examination and acknowledgment of the wife, was admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and Sale from Benjamin Griffen to John P. Mayton conveying a tract of 30 1/2 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 21st day of December 1840 by the said Benjamin Griffen and admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and Sale from Benjamin Griffen to Joseph B. Grimes conveying a tract of 5 1/2 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 21st of December 1840 by the said Benjamin Griffen and admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and Sale from Benjamin Griffen to John P. Mayton conveying 155 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 21st of December 1840 by the said Benjamin Griffen and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Stephen M. Westinghouse of the first part Thurgood Lane of the second part and Calvin J. Stephenson of the third part conveying 45 1/2 acres of land and two negroes Ann and Rachel was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 21st of December by the witnesses thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Elizabeth Drake of the first part William Drake of the second part and Drury of the third part conveying her interest in 113 acres of land and not held all his stock of hogs, cattle &c and his crop of corn and fodder &c was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 21st of December 1840 and admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and Sale from Samuel Westbrooke and Mary B. his wife to Thomas B. Westbrooke conveying a tract of 160 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 21st of December 1840 by Samuel Westbrooke and admitted to record.

Deed of Release from Leitch Ellsworth R. Edwards of the first Edwards Reels & others of the second part and Thomas B. Jones of the third part releasing a certain lot or piece of land situated on and adjacent to the Town of Jerusalem known as the Town lot, household and kitchen furniture belonging to the same, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 22nd of December 1840 by S. R. Edwards the trustee and admitted to record.
