

On the motion of Samuel Drury who produced the Sheriff's receipt for the tax imposed by Law a

This cause came on this day to be heard in the bill, answer and argument of counsel; and was  
docketed by court, on consideration whereof, the Court doth order, judge and decree, that all the  
estate real of which John Harris did die, and so forth shall be sold on a credit of six months  
except so much as may be necessary to defray the expenses of the sale. The slaves shall be sold off  
as possible for a division to trade places if not to sell for cash. and that the commissioners herein  
after named take seven loads with good security or equal amounts and deliver them to the  
plaintiff and defendant respectively this suit upon their according to the Committee of the estate  
of John Harris the necessary and proper returning loads. That is to say the said Commissioner  
shall deliver one load for me seventh part of the funds arising from said sale to James H. Harris  
one load of like nature to Randolph Harris, one to William C. Harris - unto D. C. Peabody in  
right of his wife Elizabeth formerly Harris - one to Estevan R. Stevens in right of his wife  
Mary formerly Harris, one to Silas Tolson in right of his wife Nancy formerly Harris, and  
one to Joseph A. Raymond as guardian to Gedson A. Harris infant son of Willis Harris dec'd.  
And the Court doth further decree that Edwards Duley be appointed Commissioner to  
sell and make conveyance of said property, and that the expenses of this suit be jointly  
borne by the parties.

On the motion of Sam Morris Sheriff and Committee of the estate of John Harris dec'd  
Ordered that Estevan R. Edwards who is hereby appointed Commissioner for the purpose  
do state, settle and adjust an account of the said Rev's administration as he judgeth fit  
and make report to Court.

A writing in other words "In the name of God Amens. I Rose Hill of the County of Middle  
sex & State of N<sup>a</sup>. do make & publish this my last Will & Testament in manner and form following  
to wit: Item. first. It is my will & desire that all of my just debts should be paid.  
Item. I give and bequeath to Miss Jemima M<sup>a</sup>lamore one hundred dollars to her and her heirs  
forever. Item. I give and bequeath to my brother Lewis Duley fifty dollars to him and his heirs  
forever. Item. I give and bequeath the balance of my estate to my brother Thomas' daughter,  
Rebecca Jones, to her and her heirs forever. I nominate and appoint my friend Nathaniel  
Linn, and my old Execution to this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof I have  
set my hand & seal this 15<sup>th</sup> day of January year of our Lord 1841.
