Deed of Bargain and Sale from Martha Griffin to Nathaniel Turner conveying a tract of four acres of land was proved in the Clerks Office on the 18<sup>th</sup> January 1841 by Benjamin Griffin, Sam Rivers and Nathan Turner the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Nathaniel Turner and Henry his wife to Martha Griffin conveying a tract of one and a half acres of land was proved in the Clerks Office on the 18<sup>th</sup> January 1841 by Benjamin Griffin, Sam Rivers and Nathan Turner the witnesses thereto and together with the certificate annexed of the privity examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Henry Booth and Lucy his wife to John B. Worth conveying a tract of 49 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 18<sup>th</sup> January 1841 by Henry Booth and together with the certificate annexed of the privity examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Henry Booth and Lucy his wife to Patrick H. Bowles conveying a tract of 50 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 18<sup>th</sup> January 1841 by John B. Worth and Patrick H. Bowles and together with the certificate annexed of the privity examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Elizabeth J. Branch of the first part, Lambeth Mathews of the second part and Benjamin Branch and James H. Wind of the third part conveying a tract of 117 acres of land was proved in the Clerks Office on the 18<sup>th</sup> January 1841 by John B. Worth one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the Office on the 25<sup>th</sup> September 1840 by Herbert Dower as to Elizabeth Branch and on the 1<sup>st</sup> August 1840 was acknowledged in the Clerks Office by Lambeth Mathews one of the parties thereto and proved as to the parties thereto by Martin Besille the other witness thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Henry Booth and Lucy his wife to Charles J. Brabaw conveying a tract of 431 acres acre of land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 17<sup>th</sup> January 1841 by Henry Booth and together with the certificate annexed of the privity examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Willis Braddock to Drew Holt conveying a tract of 107 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 18<sup>th</sup> January 1841 by Willis Braddock and admitted to Record.
