Dowers and Nathan Turner the witnesses thereto and together with the certificate thereto annexed of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Henry North and Lucy his wife to John H. North conveying a tract of 490 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 18th Jan^y 1841 by Henry North and together with the certificate annexed of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Henry North and Lucy his wife to Patrick H. Keeling conveying a tract of 50 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 18th January 1841 by the said John H. North and together with the certificate annexed of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Elizabeth D. Branch of the first part, Lambert Mathews of the second part and Benjamin Branch and James H. Bond of the third part conveying a tract of 117 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 18th January 1841 by John H. North one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the Office on the 21st September 1830 by Richard Turner as to Elizabeth Branch and on the 17th August 1830 was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office by Lambert Mathews one of the parties thereto and proved as to the other parties thereto by Elston Beattie the other witness thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Henry North and Lucy his wife to Nicholas J. Barber conveying a tract of 181 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 18th January 1841 by Henry North and together with the certificate annexed of the proxy examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Willis Bradshaw to Drew Holt conveying a tract of 100 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 18th January 1841 by Willis Bradshaw and admitted to record.
