This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and at appearing to the Court that the defendants have had legal notice of this action they were personally called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff may have execution against the Defendants for One hundred and twenty dollars and fifty cents the penalty of the said bond and his costs by him in this behalf expended. And the said Defendants on Mercy &c. But this execution may be discharged by the payment of fifty six dollars and twenty five cents with legal interest thereon from the 19th day of October 1840 till paid and the costs.

The last Will and Testament of Joshua Howard deceased was proved by the oath of George B. Griffin William B. Griffin and Benet Sadler the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded, and on the motion of Benjamin Griffin one of the Executors therein named who made oath and together with Eld. Jopner and Robert B. Griffin his decesses entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs. Certificate is granted him for standing 'a' probat thereof in due form. James Jones the other executor therein named refused to take upon himself any part of the burthen of the execution of said will.

Ordered that James Jones William B. Griffin Giles B. Whiting and Nathaniel Turner or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Joshua Howard deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of Eliza Ingers Ordered that he be exempt from the payment of Taxes &c for his slave Nancy in future she being aged and infirm.

On the motion of Thomas Pringle Sheriff of this County James H. Schell is permitted to qualify as his deputy during his pleasure, and thereupon the said Schell qualified by taking the several oaths required by Law. It appearing to the Court that the said Schell is a man of honesty probity and good demeanour.

On the motion of Benet B. R. Whiffelsh Ordered that the estate of David B. Matthews deceased be committed to the hands of Thomas Pringle Sheriff of this County for administration according to Law.

Ordered that the Oursers of the poor bond Hannah and Rachel children of Giller Brown free negro, to Mary Ann O'Neale according to Law: that they covenant with
