Blanchard for his committal in the estate of Eliza Richards deceased, it is ordered that the said Blanchard be committed to appear here immediately to show cause why he should not be called to give the said Mason & Parker counter Security, whereupon the said Blanchard appears and acknowledged the source of this action and being heard, it is ordered that he give the said Mason & Parker good Counter Security, the sum for which purpose is to be in the sum of five hundred dollars and conditioned as the law directs, and the said Blanchard refusing to give the said Security it is ordered that the sum and dollars of the said Blanchard as administrator aforesaid be arrested.

Ordered that the unadministered estate of Eliza Richards deceased be committed to the hands of Thomas Peeler Sheriff of this County for administration according to law.

Ordered that Master Lemuel F. Cobb examine State and Settle James D. H. Pond's transactions as Receiver of Edina Branch and make report to the Court with any matter specially stated demand pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
