

Deed of Bargain & Sale from Mary Williams to James P French conveying a tract of 81 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres of land was purv'd in the Clerks Office on the 19th February 1841 by James W Parker, as of the witness thereat and having been before purv'd in the Clerks Office on the 15th February 1841 by Henry D'Vaughn and Daniel St Domingo, two other witnesses thereto was admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain & Sale from Sallie A Edwards to James P French conveying a tract of 50 acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 19th February 1841 by the said Sallie A Edwards and admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from James P French to Henry D'Vaughn conveying a tract of 413 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres of land was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 19th February 1841 by the said James P French and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Mills A Britt of the first part Jonathan Darden of the second part and Elizabeth Birth of the third part, conveying all his household Utchess furniture farming utensils &c was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 23rd February 1841 by Mills A Britt and Jonathan Darden two of the trustees thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between William Howard of the first part Sethre Bell of the second part and Randolph Fowler of the third part conveying one horse, one cart and wheel, two beds, 38 pieces of furniture and all else the household Utchess furniture, one son and all his crop of corn fed day born of, farming utensils &c was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 15th March 1841 by William Howard one of the trustees thereto and admitted to record.

The account current of Ezra Morris administration on John Harris' estate having been one sum and no exceptions being filed was confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

The account current of Benjamin Griffis administration on Edith Bradshaw's estate having been one sum and no exceptions being filed was confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

Convent Judkins widow of Joseph W Judkins, Clara Ann, Willow & Cornelia J and Margaret Judkins infants of Joseph W Judkins by Convent Judkins their next friend, Pet'r [In Chancery] against William Judkins administrator of Joseph W Judkins dec'd. afft.

On consideration whereof the Court approves and confirms the said report with order that the same be made firm and stable and binding between the parties and that the costs be proportionably borne between the said parties.
