

William at Farnwell, Richard Farnwell, Polly at Farnwell and

The Commissioner appointed to make sale of the land whereof Elias Farnwell did die
this day made report which is in these words "For the County of New Kent, in conformity to the several decree, the
undersigned did advertise the sale of the lands mentioned therein, giving the notice required, and on
the 19th day of December 1840, sold to the highest bidder on a credit of nine months the plantation
whereof Elias Farnwell resided at the time of his death, containing by a late survey 386 acres
and Joseph G Council became the purchaser thereof for the sum of thirteen hundred & fifty
dollars, deduct the expenses of the sale, say \$10. 38 Cents in all, say \$10. 00 for Commissioners
fee, \$2.50 for clerks fee, & \$18. 00 Surveyor fee making the sum of \$60. 38 Cents,
thus last sum take from the gross amount leaves the sum of \$12. 91. 62 Cents, this sum divided
into four equal parts makes the sum of \$3. 22 1/2 each legatee's part in the homestead.
I have taken five bonds of the said J G Council with sufficient security, each of the amount
last named payable to the legatees, and turned them over to the proper guardians. The last tract named
contained 305 acres by a late survey - Given under my hand this 19th day of December
1840. Wm. Griffon Commissioner.

On the motion of Edwards Battle who made oath and with William J Cobbett and Benjamin
Griffins his securities entered into and acknowledged it a bond in the penalty of two thousand dollars
conditioned as the law directs certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration
on the estate of his deceased wife Rebecca A Battle in due form -
