This cause came on this day to be heard by consent of parties, on the bill and answer, was decided by consent, and argued by Counsel; on consideration whereof, the Court doth assigne, order and decree that William Briggs, Jesse Drury, Harry J. Briggs and Samuel B. Thomas, any three of them, who are hereby appointed Commissioners for the purpose, proceed to divide the slaves in the bill mentioned, namely, Willis, Jane, Harry, Eliza, Roger, Rasmall, Betty, Sally, Estlin, Dick, Ephraim, Louisa, & Nat. Marine, Washington, Matilda, Schom, Chama, & transient, Mary Louisa and Charlotte being the slaves held by Rebecca D. Dault formerly Gurley as then slaves in the following proportions, that is to say, that they set apart and allot $\frac{2}{3}$ part of the same (to wit, three tenths seven hundredths & two thousandths of the value of the whole) to Edwards Dault as purchaser of the rights and interests of Wm. D. Gurley; a like proportion to the guardian of the infant complainant John W. Gurley; $\frac{1}{3}$ part of the same (to wit, one tenth two hundredths, four thousandths of the value of the whole) to the defendant Edwards Dault as administrator of his deceased wife Rebecca formerly Gurley; $\frac{1}{3}$ part of the same (to wit, no tenth three hundredths and five thousandths of the value of the whole) to the guardian of the infant complainant Emma R. Dault, a like proportion to the defendant Edwards Dault in his own right; and $\frac{0.12}{100}$ part of the same (to wit, no tenth six hundredths and two thousandths of the value of the whole) to the guardian of the infant complainant James J. Dault; and that they make report of their proceedings, with a view to a final decree.
