that the guardian be authorized to use the principal of the wards estate for his support, the
interest and profits arising therefrom being insufficient for the purpose.

An account of William V Corbitts guardianship of William H Corbitt was returned and
ordered to be recorded.

Accounts of George H Gardner guardianship of Elizabeth M, Isaac O. Louisa J.
and Margaret Ann Gardner were returned and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Thomas Proctor Sheriff of this County, Edwards Ruttle, William Corbitt,
James H Corbitt, Jesse Drury and William M Corbett are permitted to qualify as his depu-
ties during his pleasure, and thereupon they qualified by taking the oaths prescribed by
law. It appearing to the Court that the said Edwards Ruttle, William J Corbitt, James H
Corbitt, Jesse Drury and William M Corbett are men of honest probity and good manners.

Ordered that John Wagoner, Jerusalem, W. Morgan and Joel Perkins or any two of them
with commissioners appointed by the Court of Sale of Wight County, let to the lowest bidder
the repair of Broad Water bridge, receive the same when completed and make report to
Court.

James J Williams having obtained an attachment against the estate of Gray Edwards
who absconds or conceals himself so that the ordinary process of law cannot be served upon him for
\$8.00/100 with interest from the 8th day of April 1837 and on the same of \$4.00/100 with
interest from the 25th day of January 1837 and with the sum of \$7.00/100 with interest from
the 5th day of April. And the Constable having made return that he had attached in the
hands of John M Bell the sum of 83 cents, William Deale the sum of \$2.00, Hyeckiah Wood-
shaw 1.00, John Drake 2.00. one dollar of which has been paid by Hyeckiah Woodshaw and
summoned William Davis and Edwards Ruttle to say what amount they owe the said
Edwards. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and the said Gray Edwards
not appearing it is considered by the Court that the said Williams recover against said
Edwards the sums aforesaid with interest thereon as aforesaid, to wit the sum of \$8.00/100
with interest from the 8th day of April 1837, the sum of \$4.00/100 with interest from the 25th
day of January 1837 and the sum of \$7.00/100 with interest from the 5th day of April ---
and his costs by him in this behalf expended. That William Deale pay the plaintiff
the sum of \$2. Hyeckiah Woodshaw the sum of \$1. and John Drake the sum of \$2.
