Sheriff Johnson who stands bound by recognizance for his appearance here to answer the complaint of John Hollands and William Howell against him for a breach of the peace this day appeared in discharge of his recognizance, and the said Hollands and Howell being sworn and examined and the said Johnson fully heard. It is the opinion of the Court and accordingly ordered that the said Johnson give security for his keeping the sum for the Term of twelve months from this day, himself to be bound in the sum of One hundred Dollars, with two securities in the sum of fifty dollars each, and that the said Johnson pay the costs of this prosecution, and that he be committed to jail until the said security be given.

On the motion of the plaintiff a copy of the bill which has been duly served to is substituted for the original bill. This cause came onto be debated and heard by consent of parties, upon the bill, answers of the several defendants, the exhibits filed in the cause, and the depositions of sundry witnesses, and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof of the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Nathaniel M Osborne be appointed a Commissioner on the part of the infant defendants to sell their undivided interest in the tract of land described in the bill of the complainant "as poplar swamp or Allens quarter" supposed to contain six thousand two hundred and forty six acres either in whole or in such parts as may be sold to the greatest advantage on a credit of one, two and three years by equal annual instalments, except one third of the purchase money, which shall be for cash, running the bill until the whole amount of the purchase money shall be paid - and the said Commissioner is further directed to make report to this Court in order to a final decree.

The Court doth assign John M Garley guardian to John W Garley orphan of Henry Garley deceased, and thereupon the said John M Garley together with Edwards Buell and William A Spark his brothers entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of Ten Thousand Dollars conditioned according to law.
