

The Court after fully hearing the parties by their attorneys decided that the administration be granted to the said Alfred S Bailey upon his taking the oath prescribed by law and entering into bond with security conditioned as the law directs. Whereupon the said Alfred S Bailey took the oath prescribed by law and with James W Argubart, Richard A Argubart and Robert Murray his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one hundred thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs a certificate is awarded him for obtaining letters of administration de bonis etis on the estate of James Telt dec^d with his bond well annexed in due form.

Samuel Johnson with A D Argubart, Thomas C Jones, Elizabeth Johnson, John Baynes and Jacob W Telt his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto Thomas W Palmer Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, the said Johnson in the sum of One hundred dollars and his said securities in the sum of twenty dollars each, of their respective goods and chattels, lands and Tenements to be levied and to the said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth ordered. Yet upon this condition that if the said Samuel Johnson shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth, more especially towards John S Holland and William Howell for the space of twelve months from this day then the above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

An Inventory and Appraisement of the estate of Hannah Sumners dec^d was returned and ordered to be recorded.

On the motion of Seths Cobb and Seth S Williams securities for William Melt as guardians of the persons of Jonathan Baynes dec^d Ordered that the said Melt be summoned to the next Term of this Court to show cause, if any he can, why he should not be ruled to give the said Cobb and Williams good counter security according to law.

Nathan Turner and Miles Whitney are appointed commissioners in pursuant 7th 29 in the name of Can Runners and Jefe Landford excused.

On the motion of James Baynes administrator of Siles Summalls dec^d Ordered that Siles R Edwards who is hereby appointed commissioner for the purpose, State, settle and adjust Siles Summalls administration in Charles W Goodwens estate and make report to the Court.

Ordered that the Overseers of the poor bind Madison Morgan and Abraham children of Avery Morgan for negro, to Polly Brattle according to law, covenanting with the said Polly Brattle that she pay to the mother of said children the sum of \$5 per annum for each child except the last years apprenticeship, the sum for that year as he has paid to the said apprentices respectively.

Samuel S James is appointed Constable in the upper district of Aftonny parish in this County till July Court 1842 and thereupon he took the oath prescribed by Law and with Thomas C Jones and Samuel W Woods his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned according to Law, which bond is ordered to
