

The Court after fully hearing the parties by their attorneys decided that the administration be granted to the said Alfred S. Bailey upon his taking the oaths prescribed by law and entering into bond with security conditioned as the law directs. Whereupon the said Alfred S. Bailey took the oaths prescribed by law and with James B. Urquhart, Richard A. Urquhart and Robert Murray his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One hundred thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs a certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration de bonis mortis on the estate of James Scott deceased with his said will annexed in due form -

Edmund Johnson with A. B. Urquhart, Thomas O' Jones, Elizabeth Johnson, John Raynor and Jacob W. Scott his securities herein Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto Thomas W. Elmer Esq. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, the said Johnson in the sum of One hundred dollars and his said debtors in the sum of Twenty dollars each, of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be liable and to the said Governor and his executors for the use of the Commonwealth rendered. But upon this condition that if the said Edmund Johnson shall keep the peace and be of good behavior towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth, more especially towards John H. Holland and William Howell for the space of twelve months from this day, then the above recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

An Inventory and Appraisement of the estate of Annals Summons deceased was returned and ordered to be sealed.

On the motion of John Cobb and Seth D. Williams securities for William Webb as guardian of the orphans of Jonathan Bryant deceased Ordered that the said Webb be summoned to the next term of this Court in due cause, if any he can, why he should not be ruled to give the said Cobb and Williams good counter security according to law.

Nathaniel Turner and Giles Whitney are appointed prothonotaries in Pursuant to No 29 on the record of our Honors and Jno. Lantford excused.

On the motion of James Relayton administrator of Silas Lummonds deceased Ordered that Peltier R. Edwards who is hereby appointed commissioner for the purpose State, settle and adjust Silas Lummonds administration in Charles H. Goodwyns estate and make report to the Court.

Ordered that the Overseers of the poor bind Madison Urquhart and Extramular Children of Avery Warren for negro, to Polly Brattle according to law, covenanting with the said Polly Brattle that she pay to the mother of said children the sum of \$5 per annum for each child except the last years apprenticeship, the sum for that year to be paid to the said apprentices respectively.

Samuel A. Jones is appointed Constable in the upper district of Attorney Branch in this County till July Court 1832 and thereupon he shall take the oaths prescribed by Law and with Thomas O' Jones and Samuel A. Jones his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned according to Law, which law is referred to
