

Holland, Samuel R. Bondney and William M. Jones be appointed Executors, authorized to sell or public auction on a credit of nine months, requiring money to pay the expenses of this said Lewis Bondney and John negroes belonging to the estate of Belona Cotton dec'd, and the proceeds thereof after deducting the expenses of sale divide into three equal parts, and pay over 1/3 part to Isaac R. Smith in right of his wife Martha formerly Martha R. Cotton, 1/3 to Isaac R. Smith guardian for Mary R. Cotton, and the remaining 1/3 to Isaac R. Smith guardian to Allen Cotton, and make return to this Court how they have executed the same.

The last Will and Testament of Kinschey Joyner deceased was proved by the oath of Edgely Joyner and James Joyner two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded, and Aggy Joyner the executrix therein named desiring to take upon herself the burden of the execution thereof on the motion of William Joyner who made oath and together with Polly Joyner, Cassin Sumner and James Joyner his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of the said Kinschey Joyner deceased with his said Will annexed in due form.

On the motion of Bennett R. Whitfield who made oath and together with Benjamin Davis and Jonathan Barber his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Nancy Magot dec'd in due form.

Ordered that Isaac Ellsworth, Thomas B. Worrell, Richard J. Dwyer and Benjamin J. Davis or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Nancy Magot deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of Jacob Vick who made oath and together with Jacob Davis and Matthew Vick his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of James Vick deceased in due form.

Ordered that Benjamin Davis, Isaac Ellsworth, Thomas B. Worrell and Jacob Vick or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of James Vick dec'd and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Samuel Pope is appointed Surveyor of the route from Vicks Bluffs to Crossedwood in the range of Matthew Vick entered, and it is ordered that the usual funds do work therein.

On the motion of John R. Channell. Ordered that the unadministered estate of William Blount be committed to the hands of Thomas Proctor Sheriff of this County for administration according to law.
