

The order heretofore made committing the estate of a widow for her descent to the Sheriff for administration is set aside. And on the motion of Henry Bowler who made the same and together with Benjamin Griffen and others of said County his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned at the place where certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the said ~~the~~ Rachel Gwynne estate with his will annexed in due form -

Ordered that Edwin Waller, Matthew Price and Levi C. Waller being first duly sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of said James Jones & return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Ordered that Littleton R Edwards examine State and settle Edward Bell's guardianship of John W. Harley and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Littleton R Edwards who heretofore appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose to State, settle and adjust an account of Benjamin Griffins administration on Williams Lawrence's estate and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that William M. Jones who heretofore appointed Special Commissioner for the purpose to State, settle and adjust Edwin Garrison's administration on Williams L. Garrison's estate and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that Master Beaumont Cobb examine State and settle William Harris' administration on Jacob O. Harrison's estate and make report thereof to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

On the motion of Richard A. Argabright one of the securities of George Spring as a constable in this County. It is ordered that the said Spring be summoned to the next Court to give the law Argabright constable security according to Law -

On the motion of William D. Hood administrator of Benjamin M. Hancock &c. Ordered that the undivided estate of Nancy Hancock &c. be committed to the hands of Thomas Prettier Sheriff of this County for administration according to Law -

On the motion of Samuel Blunt. Ordered that the estate of Robert Willing &c. be committed to the hands of Thomas Prettier Sheriff of this County for administration according to Law.
