Butler and William Boarder his Sureties hereon Court severally acknowledging themselves to be undelized unto John Rutherford Esq. the acting Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, that is to say the said James Boarder in the sum of One hundred fifty dollars and his Sureties in the sum of fifty two dollars and fifty cents each, of their respective goods and chattels, funds and Faviements to be levied and to the said Acting Governor and his Successors in the Office of Governor for the use of the Commonwealth rendered.
