complaint of Jofe Parker against him for a breach of his bond appeared in discharge of his recognizance, and the said Jofe Parker and sundry witnesses having sworn and examined and the said James T Moore by his attorney fully heard. The Court after hearing the testimony and from all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the said James T Moore gave security for his keeping the peace for the space of one year from this day, that is to say the said James T Moore in the sum of five hundred dollars with two securities in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars each. And that the said Moore pay the costs of this prosecution.

Whereupon the said James T Moore with Brian Vaughan and Jofe Cobb his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto John Rutherford Esquire the acting Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, that is to say the said James T Moore in the sum of five hundred dollars and the said Brian Vaughan and Jofe Cobb in the sum of two hundred and fifty dollars each of their respective goods and chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to the said acting governor and his successors in the Office of Governor to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon this condition that of the said James T Moore shall keep the peace and be of good behaviour towards the Commonwealth and all its citizens more especially towards the said Jofe Parker for the space of one year from this day when this recognizance to be made or due to remain in full force and virtue.

The last Will and Testament of Holladay Revelle deceased was proved by the oath of Andrew Pope and Cordy Pope one of the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. John Turner one of the executors therein named refusing to take upon himself the burden of the execution thereof. On the motion of Augustin Pope the other executor therein named who made oath and together with John C Turner and James Worrell his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of seven hundred dollars conditioned according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

Ordered that John Ellsworth, Job Nick, Benjamin Dumb and Matthew Nick or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose to appraise all the personal estate of Holladay Revelle deceased and return the appraisement unto their hands to the Court.

The Court with affix Leamy Holt guardian to Mary Ann and Virginia Ann Holler daughters of Alvin Holt deceased and therfore the said Leamy Holt with Augustin Pope and James Worrell his securities where unto and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of twelve hundred dollars conditioned according to law.

The Registers of Ben Crocker, Mary Borrough and John Foreman for record are examined and certified to be truly made.

The account current and Commissioners report of Alvin Holler's administration of John A Brattle's estate was returned and ordered to be no sum for exceptions.
