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Case of

complaint of Jesse Parker against him for a breach of the peace appeared in discharge of his recognizance, and the said Jesse Parker and sundry witnesses being sworn and examined and the said James T. Moore by his attorney fully heard. The Court after hearing the testimony and from all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the said James T. Moore give security for his keeping the peace for the space of one year from this day, that is to say the said James T. Moore in the sum of five hundred dollars with two securities in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars each. And that the said Moore pay the costs of this prosecution. Whereupon the said James T. Moore with Orrin Vaughan and Jesse Cobb his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto John Rutherford Esquire the acting Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, that is to say the said James T. Moore in the sum of five hundred dollars and the said Orrin Vaughan and Jesse Cobb in the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars each of their respective goods and chattels lands and Tenements to be levied and to the said acting Governor and his Successors in the Office of Governor to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. Yet upon their condition that if the said James T. Moore shall keep the peace and be of good behavior towards the Commonwealth and all its citizens more especially towards the said Jesse Parker for the space of one year from this day then this recognizance to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.

The last Will and Testament of Holladay Revell deceased was proved by the oaths of Andrew Pope and Emily Pope two of the subscribing witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded. Shute Turner one of the executors therein named refusing to take upon himself the burden of the execution thereof on the motion of Augustus Pope the other executor therein named she made oath and together with John Edmonson and James Worrell his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of seven hundred dollars conditioned according to law certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said will in due form.

Ordered that Selah Colwell, Joel Wick, Benjamin Dunn and Matthew Dick or any three of them being first duly sworn before a Justice of the peace for that purpose do appraise all the personal estate of Holladay Revell dec^d and return the appraisement under their hands to the Court.

The Court with advice Leamy Holt guardian to Mary Ann and Virginia Ann Holt orphans of Lewis Holt dec^d and thereupon the said Leamy Holt with Augustus Pope and James Worrell his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of five hundred dollars conditioned according to Law.

The Requests of Ben Boscher, Mary Brought and John Foreman for negroes were examined and certified to be truly made.

The account current and Commissions report of Alfred J. Nettles administrator of John A. Brinkley estate was returned and ordered to be returned to him for acceptance.

The account current and Commissions report of Matthew Nettles administrator of Hudson Rogers estate was returned and ordered to be returned to him for acceptance.
