And thereupon sundry witnesses were sworn and examined and the process fully heard in his defence. The Court after hearing the testimony & from all the circumstances of the case are of opinion and do accordingly order that the prisoner be discharged from further prosecution for the said supposed offence.

Ordered that the Sheriff summon all the acting justices of the peace for this County to the next Term of this Court to lay and advise the County levy.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
