Deed of Trust between Pelage Barrow of the first part, Alexander Myrick of the second part and Davis Bryant of the third part, conveying three beds, all his household and kitchen furniture, all his stock of horses, hogs &c apple mill and four farming utensils &c was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of May 1841, by Pelage Barrow, Alexander Myrick and Davis Bryant the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Jesse J Parker and Edith his wife to James Gray conveying a tract of 204¹/₂ acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of May 1841 by the oath of James Magot, Alexander Myrick and Jacob Williams the witnesses thereto and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between William Mallory of the first part James J French of the second part and Samuel H Marks of the third part conveying one negro man Sam was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of May 1841 by William Mallory and James J French two of the parties thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Augustus J Westbrook and Emily his wife to Joseph D Cloud conveying a tract of 235¹/₂ acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of May 1841 by the oath of Edmund B Cloud one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved in the Office on the 19th day of April 1841 by the oath of William J Harris and Solomon D Parker two other witnesses thereto, was together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John Lewis and Catherine his wife, Jacob Wade and Sallie his wife to Galy Janner conveying a tract of 55 acres of land was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of May 1841 by the oath of Jeremiah Janner, Abraham Janner and Jeremiah Janner the witnesses thereto and admitted to record.
