Ordered that Solomon D Parker, Burkham Morris, Henry Pottway and Samuel Richardson being first sworn before a justice of the peace his truly and justly approve all the personal and real estate of Joseph Blanton do^r in the County which may be then produced or shown and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

Butler & Clements Butler to come to us voluntarily and deposed to give evidence.

Hannah P. Reece for an assault and battery upon the body of Edward Weston of the first name of Edward Weston in the County of Southampton on the first day of June Inst, upon the information of Edward Weston who was sent for and sworn in Court to give evidence.

Willis A. Willis for an assault and battery upon the body of Thomas Lawrence by Hobbington, striking said Lawrence at T. J. Mathews Tavern in the Town of Southampton in the County of Southampton upon the evidence of Thomas Lawrence who came voluntarily before the grand jury.

Richard Clements for an assault and battery upon the body of Joseph Holt at the Cross Keys in the County of Southampton sometime in the month of April last upon the evidence of David Neiman and Louis Morell two of their body.

Collin Ferguson for an assault and battery upon the body of Wells Dick at the late residence of
