

Henry Magot die in the County of Southampton some time in April last report the information of Matthew Neale one of their body & Benjamin Dennis who was sent for and sworn in Court to give evidence - John Drake & Edmund Jopson for an assault and battery on the body of Charles Ingraham at the house of the said Ingraham in the County of Southampton summoned as the month of May last report the information of Charles Ingraham who came voluntarily and was sworn in Court to give evidence - And the grand jury having nothing further to present were discharged -

The Court hereby authorizes the grand jury to dispense with the examination of the jail of this County -

On the motion of James James and Thomas C Jones who severally petitioned the Court for relief from the tax imposed by law, and the said James James with Samuel J Jones his security, and the said Thomas C Jones with Samuel J Douglas his security, severally entered into bond with the penalty of one hundred and fifty dollars conditioned as the law directs, a license them to keep an Ordinary that is to say the said James James at his residence in this County and the said Thomas C Jones at his lot in Foreland in this County till May Term next. It appearing to the Court that the said James James & Thomas C Jones are men of good character and not addicted to drunkenness or gaming -

On the motion of Edwards Wells against Samuel M Pond and Nicholas Pond. This day came the plaintiff by his attorney and it appearing to the Court that the defendants have had legal notice of this motion they were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered by the Court that the plaintiff recover against the defendants the sum of sixteen dollars and fifty two cents with interest thereon from the 26th day of August 1830 till the 23rd day of September 1832 and the further sum of ten dollars & eighty six cents with legal interest thereon from the 26th day of September 1832 till the said 23rd day of September 1832 (being the sums collected by the said Samuel M Pond in the character of Constable) and which he has refused to pay to the plaintiff) together with fifteen per cent damages for the whole amount thereof from the said 23rd day of September 1832 till paid - and his costs by him about heretofore in this behalf expended. Ordered that John R Chumbley Commissioner of the Court of Greenfield State settle and adjust James W Newsons guardian account of William J Nicholas and make a report thereof to Court.
