

"As directed on the order annexed, we have viewed the contemplated change in the location of the road near Henry D. Vaughan's and concur unanimously in the opinion that both the public interest and convenience as well as that of Mr. Vaughan will have been effected by the proposed alteration. On the motion of Matthew R. Pope - Ordered that Master Commissioners Bell examine, state and settle the said Pope's administration on Esther Jevons estate, and make report thereof to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

John M. Gandy and Samuel Kello severally rendered on each a list of their taxable property, and complied with the law concerning return by keepers, merchants &c.

John M. Gandy and Samuel Kello severally produced to the Court an account of their services as Commissioners of the Revenue and the Court have considered that surely fees for such were required for the said Commissioners to perform the powers aforesaid

Ordered that the whole of Matthew Bracke do^r be committed to the hands of Thomas Butler Sheriff of this County for administration according to law.

An Account Current and Commissioners report of Benjamin Griffin's administration over H. C. Lawrence estate was returned and ordered to be on view for everything.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till to morrow morning Nine O'Clock!
