Deed of Bargain and Sale from Ethelbert Bradshaw and Elizabeth his wife to Hensley McElroy conveying a tract of land containing 28 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June 1841 by Ethelbert Bradshaw and together with the certificate annexed of the Survey examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Release from James D Lundy of the first part, Lou Waller of the second part and Samuel Drury of the third part releasing a tract of land containing 500 acres more or less, also the following slaves Thomas, Alfred and Joseph was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 25<sup>th</sup> of June 1841 by James D Lundy and Lou Waller two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between Lou Waller of the first part James D Lundy of the second part and Nathan D Francis of the third part conveying a tract of land containing 300 acres more or less, also the following slaves Joseph, Willis Nancy, Isab. Fanny, Newman, Jack Billy, Henry and David, was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June 1841 by James D Lundy and Lou Waller two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between James Obrighton of the first part Littleton R Edwards of the second part and Richard Holcomb of the third part conveying one negro boy named Abel aged about 16 years was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of June 1841 by two of the parties thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Bennett J Griffin and his wife to Edwards Kilburn conveying a tract of land containing 9 acres & Rod and Isabella was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of July 1841 by Bennett J Griffin and together with the certificate annexed of the Survey examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to Record.
