 same which will amount for the purchase money of said land. All which is respectfully sub-
 mitted. Given under our hands this 12th day of June 1841. Wm M Jones, Recorder of the
 land.

 parish in this County at the last Term this day took the several oaths prescribed by law
 and with Peter B Beckman and William M Everett his securities entered into and
 acknowledged a bond on the penalty of five thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs
 which bond is ordered to be recorded.

Martha J Washburn the widow of John J Washburn deceased appeared in Court and declared
 that she will not take or accept the provisions made for her by the will of her said husband
