

shall have and receive all the apportions enforced upon the former Trustee Joseph Patton by the affidavit deed of Test bearing date the 19th day of October 1824 to which the said Matthew Drake, James Smith and Joseph Patton were parties and that the said John Denny shall in all respects be substituted for the former Trustee Joseph Patton. And it is further ordered and decreed that the costs of this suit be proportionally borne by the parties.

For reasons appearing to the Court the Indentures by which Henry Stokes, son by, was bound to Matthew Drake are hereby transferred to Matthew Drake.

Ordered that Master Benjamin Bell examine state and settle an account of John A. Persons administration in Virginia A. Newsoms estate and make report thereof to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

Ordered that Master Benjamin Bell examine state and settle an additional account of John A. Persons administration in David Newsoms estate and make report thereof to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which he may be required to state.

For reasons appearing to the Court. Ordered that the Overseers of the poor Said Overseers apportion to Benjamin Bell according to law, concomitantly with the said Bell that he pay, Bertha Warren the mother of said boy five dollars on his said boys arriving at the age of four years seven dollars on his arrival at the age of eleven years, nine dollars on his arrival at the age of thirteen years, ten dollars on his arrival at the age of fifteen years, twelve dollars on his arrival at the age of seventeen years, fourteen dollars on his arrival at the age of nineteen years, sixteen dollars on his arrival at the age of twenty years, twenty dollars on his arrival at the age of twenty two years, twenty five dollars on his arrival at the age of twenty four years and twenty five dollars to be paid to her said apprentice at the age of twenty one years.

Ordered that the Overseers of the poor receive on their list Abraham James fifteen upset shades of Marquise Glover and provide for her according to law.

On the motion of Abraham Riddick against James C. Smith guardian to Henry C. Smith Allen Attorney for count of Breach - That any the said James C. Smith with William P. Craft, General R. Gardner, John Johnson and Thomas Hartman his securities here in Court entered into bond in the penalty of Two thousand dollars (payable to the said Abraham Riddick and condition all as the law directs which security was accepted by the said Riddick.

Be it remembered that William Howell with Anthony M. Howell and Isaac Bell his securities here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto John Lutherford Esq Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia that is to say the said William Howell in the sum of Two hundred dollars and the said Anthony M. Howell and Isaac Bell in the sum of One hundred dollars each, of their respective goods and chattels lands and Tenements to be lent and to the said Lieut. Governor and his successors in the office of Governor to the use of the Commonwealth rendered. - Let after this condition
