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that of the said William Howell Shall make his personal appearance before the Justice of the County Court of Southampton at the Courthouse of said County on the first day of the next quarterly Term of the said Court and stand his trial for the felony of which he stands charged and do my orders what by the said Court Shall be ordered and Shall not depart without the terms of the said Court then and there recognized to be and -

On the motion of Henry T Pope who made oath and together with Edwin Gardner and
Strongton Gardner his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One
Thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters
of administration on the estate of Johnson Pope deceased in due form.

Ordered that Matthew Pope, Jack Williams, William Holt and Lawrence Pope or any
three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose be appointed
to appraise all the personal estate of Johnson Pope deceased and return the appraisement under
their hands to Court.

On the motion of John M. Buckley the executors named in the last Will and Testament of
John Anderson deceased proved and recorded in this Court who made oath and together
with William A. Sparks and Ioseph Brown his securities entered into and acknowledged a
bond in the penalty of four thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs certificate is
