

That if the said William Howell shall make his personal appearance before the Justice of the County Court of Southampton at the Courtroom of said County on the first day of the next quarterly Term of the said Court and stand his trial for the felony of which he stands charged and do not receive what by the said Court shall be ordered and shall not depart without the leave of the said Court then this writ requires to be and -

On the motion of Henry T Pope who made oath and together with Edward Gardner and Abraham Gardner his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining letters of administration on the estate of Johnson Pope deceased in due form.

Ordered that Matthew Pope, Jacob Williams, William Holt and Lawrence Pope or any three of them being first sworn before a Justice of the Peace for that purpose do appear and do appraise all the personal estate of Johnson Pope deceased and return the appraisement under their hands to Court.

On the motion of John M. Gurley the executor named in the last Will and Testament of John Anderson deceased proved and recorded in this Court. who made oath and together with William A. Sparks and Jesse Drury his Sureties entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of four thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs Certificate is granted him for obtaining a probate of the said Will in due form.

Ordered that the estate of Benjamin Master deceased be committed to the hands of James Butler Sheriff of this County for administration according to Law.

The Registers of Russell Arbee, Billy Brown, Lucretia Green, Polly Brown, Henry Hicks, Lemma Roberts and Will Mathews, free negroes, were examined and certified to be truly made.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the first day of the next Term.
