

At a Court of Quarterly Sessions held for the County of Southampton on the 16th day of August 1841.

The Clerk this day returned a list of the deeds admitted to Record in the Clerk's Office of this Court since July Term 1841, to wit:-

Deed of bargain and sale from John Adell to Thomas Proctor Sheriff conveying a tract of land containing 15 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 19th day of July 1841 by John Adell and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John Backhouse and Louisa his wife to Benjamin & Peter conveying a tract of land containing 27 1/4 acres more or less was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 19th day of July 1841 by the oaths of Jacob Barnes one of the witnesses thereto, and having been before proved in the Office on the 31st day of June 1841 by Alexander Myrick and Harriet & Peter two other witnesses thereto was together with the certificate annexed of this being a confirmation and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between James James of the first part William & James of the second part and Edward P Turner of the third part conveying one negro woman Jerry was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 19th day of July 1841 by three of the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between James James of the first part Edward P Turner of the second part and James M Westbrooke of the third part conveying two negroes girls Mary and boy Henry was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 19th day of July 1841 by three of the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between James James of the first part Thomas M Westbrooke of the second part and John Evey and James M Westbrooke of the third part conveying one negro woman Marietta & children George, Anthony and Isabella and two girls Martha and Louisa who are young children was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 19th day of July 1841 by all the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Gift from William B Goodwyn to William P Goodwyn conveying a tract of land containing 50 acres more or less was returned to the Clerk's Office on the 19th day of July 1841 and with the certificate annexed admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from William B Goodwyn, Reuben P Francis and Henry Mason Commissioners to William B Goodwyn conveying a tract of land containing 36 1/2 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office the 19th of July 1841 by Reuben P Francis one of the parties thereto and having been acknowledged on the 30 July 1840 by William B Goodwyn and the party thereto was admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between James Robert of the first part Joseph M Thomas of the second part and Benjamin Griffin of the third part conveying one negro man, 2 further beds and furniture, 5 head of sheep, 2 head of cattle & 13 head of pigs was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 19th day of July 1841 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been proved on the 19th day of May 1841 by two other witnesses thereto was admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Benjamin Stark to Benjamin L Dine conveying a tract of land containing 15 acres more or less was proved in the Clerk's Office on the 19th day of July 1841 by the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.
