Deed of bargain and sale from John Abbott to Thomas Proctor Sheriff conveying a tract of land containing 15 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1821 by John Abbott and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John Barnes and Louisa his wife to Benjamin Pope conveying a tract of land containing 27 $\frac{1}{4}$  acres more or less was proved in the Clerks Office on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1821 by the wife of Jacob Barnes one of the witnesses thereto, and having been before proved in the Office on the 21<sup>st</sup> day of June 1821 by Alexander Myrick and Honora P Pope two other witnesses thereto was together with the certificate annexed of the jury examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between James James of the first part William Abbott of the second part and Edward P Turner of the third part conveying one negro woman Jerry was proved in the Clerks Office on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1821 by three of the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between James James of the first part Edward P Turner of the second part and James J Westbrooke of the third part conveying two negro girls Mary and Nancy was proved in the Clerks Office on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1821 by three of the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Trust between James James of the first part Thomas J Westbrooke of the second part and John Ivory and James D Westbrooke of the third part conveying one negro woman Maria & 3 children George, Anthony and Isabella and two girls Martha and Louisa which 5 young children was proved in the Clerks Office on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1821 by all the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of gift from William H Godwyn to William P Godwyn conveying a tract of land containing 50 acres more or less was returned to the Clerks Office on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1821 and with the certificate annexed admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from William Prince, Dennis P Evans and Harry Mason Evans jointers to William H Godwyn conveying a tract of land containing 36 $\frac{1}{4}$  acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerks Office the 19<sup>th</sup> of July 1821 by Dennis P Evans one of the parties thereto and having been acknowledged on the 20<sup>th</sup> July 1820 by William Prince another party thereto was admitted to Record.

Deed of trust between Stevens Scott of the first part Joseph A Johnson of the second part and Benjamin Griffis of the third part conveying one bay mare, 2 feather hds and furniture, 5 head of sheep, 4 head of cattle & 13 head of hog was proved in the Clerks Office on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1821 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been proved on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of May 1821 by two other witnesses thereto was admitted to Record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Benjamin Scott to Benjamin P Drew conveying a tract of land containing 15 acres more or less was proved in the Clerks Office on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July 1821 by the witnesses thereto and admitted to Record.
