On the motion of the defendant by his attorney who pleaded payment to which the plaintiff by his attorney replied generally the judgments returned in the office against the defendant are abated and the causes are continued till the next quarterly Term.

Samuel Williams a negro man slave belonging to Russell Williams of this County who hath been committed to the jail of this County charged with entering the house of Mason Pope by removing the fastening of the outer door of said house and feloniously taking and carrying away the following property to wit three ladies doily three doilies of a smaller size, four dollars of 25 cents in each, one silk handkerchief two lawn doilies, one broadcloth white Coffee pot, four yards of Calico, bed quilt about half finished, and one pair cotton stockings, the whole value amounting to thirty dollars twenty five Cents - was set to the bar in custody of the jailor of this Court (the Court summons for his trial having failed to meet) and being duly arraigned pleaded not guilty. Whereupon Sundry witnesses were sworn and examined, and the prisoner by his Counsel fully heard. The Court after hearing the testimony and from all the circumstances of the case are of opinion that the prisoner is not guilty of the felony of which he stands charged, and proclamation being made as the manner is and nothing further appearing or being alleged against the prisoner it is ordered that he be discharged from custody.

The attorney for the Commonwealth by consent of the Court, saith that he will not prosecute further or behalf of the Commonwealth against Elizabell aka Starks - cause of perjury. Therefore it is ordered that she said Elizabell be discharged from her imprisonment.

William Howell late of the County of Southwark who stands charged of being a Rioter appeared in Court in discharge of his recognizance: and the grand jury having returned the Indictment against him "not a true bill" proclamation was made as the manner is: and nothing further appearing or being alleged against him it is ordered that he be discharged from his imprisonment.

Polly Hart the widow of Matwell Hart dec^d appeared in Court and renounced the provision made for her by the will of her said husband and declared that she will take or accept the same or any part thereof.

On the motion of Drury Biles Ordered that Master Commissioner Bell summon State and settle an account of the said Biles' guardianship of Nancy Turner and make what shew to Court with any matter specially stated demand payment by himself or such person as he required to state -
