On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Benjamin L Dene executor of Hartwell Hart dec^d do according to the will of his Testator sell to the highest bidder in a parcel of more worth the said land and slaves whereof the said Hartwell Hart was seized and possessed at the time of his death, taking bonds and good security of the purchasers and that he take the bonds so as to enable him to comply with this order - that out of the sales of the land he pay to the Complainant Polly Hart widow as a portion one sixth part of the net sales to be held by her absolutely in fee simple as an equivalent of her right of dower in said land, and that she unite in the deed to the purchaser if required, relinquishing her interest in the said land, and that the Court doth also order that out of the net sales of the slaves the said Dene pay to the said Polly one sixth part of the net sales of the said slaves to be held absolutely in lieu of her right to a life estate in said slaves, and that the said Dene distribute the balance according to the will of the Testator and make report &c. If required the Executor is allowed to demand from the said Complainant her bond with security conditioned to refund due proportions of any debts or damages that may hereafter arise against said estate together with the costs attending the same.

The Court doth assign Patrick H Rollings guardian to Thomas Morris nephew of John Morris dec^d and thereupon the said Patrick H Rollings with Harrodahs Bennett, a young free gardener and Jesse H Rollings his Secured estate's wife and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.
