

(362) and child filed, and was argued by Kennard. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge and decree that B^ryanne L Dore executrix of Hartwell Hart dec^d do remanding to the will of his Testator sell to the highest bidder in a trial of nine months the land and slaves whereof the said Hartwell Hart was seized and possessed at the time of his death, taking bonds and good Security of the purchasers, and that he take the lands so as to enable him to comply with this order - that out of the sale of the land he pay to the Complainant Polly Hart under aforesaid one fourth part of the net sales to be held by her absolutely in fee simple as an equivalent of her right of dower in said lands, and that she make in the deed to the purchaser of required, relinquishing her interest in the said land, and the Court doth also order that out of the net sales of the slaves the said Dore pay to the said Polly one fourth part of the net sales of the said slaves to her absolutely in lieu of her right to a life estate in said slaves, and that the said Dore distribute the balance according to the wills of the Testator and make report &c. If required the Executor is allowed to stand from the said Complainant her bond with security conditioned to refund due proportions of any debts or demands that may hereafter arise against said estate together with the costs attending the same.

The Court doth adjudge Patrick H Rollings guardian to Atticus Morris orphan of Henry Morris dec^d and therefore the said Patrick H Rollings with Marcellus Brown, a young gardener and wife H Rollings his securities enter into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of One thousand dollars conditioned according to law.
