Richleton of the third part, conveying to the said Drakes interest in a tract of land which Mary Drake is entitled to from her father Jerome Drake Esq. 1 bed and furniture, 4 chairs, 1 iron & foot Shute, Corp of corn, fodder feed & Potatoes now growing was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 17th day of August 1841 by all the parties thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain & Sale from Jethro Charles and Polly his wife to Bennett J. Griffin conveying a tract of land containing 17½ acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 17th day of August 1841 by the said Jethro Charles and together with the certificate of the Priory examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Jeremiah Island of the first part J. T. Griffen of the second part and William Board of the third part conveying all his, the said Islands, growing crop of every description was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 18th day of August 1841 by all the parties and admitted to record.

A Marriage agreement made and entered into between Edwin Gray and Anne Gray wife of E. G. Gray was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 20th day of August 1841 by Edwin Gray one of the parties thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of Bargain and Sale from Sterling S. Lewis and Sally & his wife to William J. Scott conveying a tract of land containing 55 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerks Office on the 26th day of August 1841 by the said Sterling S. Lewis and together with the certificate annexed of the Priory examination and acknowledgement of the wife admitted to
