Deed of bargain and sale from Nancy P. Griffen to Joel Harris conveying a tract of land containing 299 acres more or less was presented in the Clerk's Office on the 18th day of August 1841 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before presented in the Office on the 17th day of April 1841 by two other witnesses thereto was admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from John Harris and Margaret wife to Sarah Wade conveying a tract of land containing 4 acres more or less, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 16th day of August 1841 by the said John Harris and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between William Johnson of the first part Jacob H. Drake of the second part and Mills & Lawrence of the third part conveying one acre and odd, three of cattle, 30 head of hogs, 2 feather beds and furniture and one cart and wheel, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 16th day of August 1841 by all the parties thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Christian Jordan to Robert P. Barnes conveying a tract of land containing 22 1/2 acres more or less, was presented in the Clerk's Office on the 16th day of August 1841 by all the witnesses thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from David Barrett Esq. of the Abner H. Stephenson conveying a tract of land containing 200 acres more or less, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 16th day of August 1841 by the said David Barrett and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between John Drake of the first part Jesse Drury of the second part and Samuel P. Nicholas of the third part conveying two the said tracts, interest in a tract of land which Mary Drake is entitled to from her father Irvin Drake dec'd. 1 bed and furniture, 4 chairs, 1 iron stove, 1 pair of corn fodder press & potatoes were growing was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of August 1841 by all the parties thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Arthur Charles and Sally his wife to Donnell J. Griffen conveying a tract of land containing 170 acres more or less was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 17th day of August 1841 by the said father Charles and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between Jeremiah Mauds of the first part J. T. Griffen of the second part and William Barden of the third part conveying all his the said Mauds, growing crop of every description was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 18th day of August 1841 by all the parties and admitted to record.

A marriage agreement made and entered into between Odium Gray and Anne Gray wife of S. D. Gray, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 20th day of August 1841 by Odium Gray one of the parties thereto and admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Sterling B. Lewis and Sally C. his wife to William J. L. Bell conveying a tract of land containing 85 acres more or less, was acknowledged in the Clerk's Office on the 20th day of August 1841 by the said Sterling B. Lewis and together with the certificate annexed of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.
