On the motion of Edward G Crumpler. Ordered that the Clerk of this Court receive of the said Crumpler the amount of his note and interest thereon, which note is filed in the Office of this Court, taken as a part of the Sale of William Fowler's land and as the proportion of Giles Fowler of said Sale, and deliver the said Crumpler the said note upon his paying the amount thereof to the Clerk.

On the motion of Joseph Parker who made oath and together with Horace Riddick and Alister Darden his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of two hundred dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining Letters of administration on the estate of Penelope Abrams in due form.

On the motion of James E Peters who made oath and together with Henry Pettyng and John M Teller his securities entered into and acknowledged a bond in the penalty of one thousand dollars conditioned as the law directs, certificate is granted him for obtaining Letters of administration on the estate of William Barron dec'd in due form.
