in publick in the Court yard were brought into Court and having witness being examined  
and the said Taylor & Newsom fully heard. It is the opinion of the Court and accordingly  
ordered that the said Barton Taylor & David Newsom give Security for keeping the peace  
for the space of twelve months from this day, that is to say the said Taylor & Newsom  
to be bound in the sum of One hundred Dollars each with two Securities in the sum of fifty  
dollars each, and that they pay the costs of this prosecution - Whereupon the said Barton  
Taylor with George Williams and Thomas D'Beale his Securities here or Court severally  
acknowledged themselves indebted unto John Rutherford Esq<sup>r</sup> Lieutenant Governor acting  
as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, the said Barton Taylor in the sum of one  
hundred dollars and the said George Williams and Thomas D'Beale in the sum of fifty  
dollars each of their respective goods and chattels, lands and tenements to be levied and to  
the said acting Governor and his Successors in the Office of Governor to the use of the Common-  
wealth rendered - Yet upon this condition that if the said Barton Taylor shall keep  
the peace and be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth for the  
space of twelve months from the day that this recognizance to be paid or else to remain in full  
force and virtue - And the said David Newsom with Edwin Harris & Echols & Braxton  
his Securities here or Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto John Rutherford  
Esq<sup>r</sup> Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, that is to say  
the said David Newsom in the sum of One hundred dollars and the said Edwin Harris  
and Echols & Braxton in the sum of fifty dollars each, of their respective goods and  
chattels lands and tenements to be levied and to the said Governor and his Successors in  
the Office of Governor to the use of the Commonwealth rendered - Yet upon this condi-
