rendered. Yet upon this condition that of the said Richmond Edwards shall keep the peace
and be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth more especially towards
Elizabeth Dutchmans of this County for the term of twelve months from this day that this recogni-
zance to be read or else to remain in full force.

John A Turner and Mells E Lawrence having been guilty of a breach of the peace by
fighting together in public in the Court yard, were brought into Court and being heard it is
the opinion of the Court that the said John A Turner give security for his keeping the peace for
the space of twelve months from this day, that is to say, the said John A Turner to be bound
in the sum of One hundred dollars with two securities in the sum of fifty dollars each.
Whereupon the said John A Turner with Thomas G Jones and John W Rochelle his Securi-
ties here in Court severally acknowledged themselves indebted unto John Rutherford Esq:
Lieutenant Governor acting as Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia, the said John
A Turner in the sum of One hundred dollars and the said Jones & Rochelle in the sum of
fifty dollars each, of their respective goods and chattels lands and Tenements to be levied
and to the said Governor and his Successors for the Office of Governor to the use of the Commonwealth
rendered. Yet upon this condition that of the said John A Turner shall keep the
peace and be of good behaviour towards all the citizens of this Commonwealth for the term of
twelve months from this day that this recognizance to be read or else to remain in full force
and virtue.

Mary Whitfield widow of Oliver Whitfield docket made choice of Bennett H Whitfield
for her guardian and thereupon she said Bennett H Whitfield with John Hargrove and
Benjamin Whitfield his securities entered into and acknowledged as bond in the penalty of two
thousand dollars conditioned according to Law.

A Deed of Virginia was Sole from John M Gurly from power to another guardian was entered
into by the said Gurly and ordered to be recorded.

It appearing to the Court that the defendants have had legal notice of this motion and they not ap-
pearing, the said motion is sustained till the next Term.
