The Comptrolers in this cause this day made their report which in these words tend
 " Pursuant to the several orders in the undersigned Comptrolers having sold to the highest
 bidder on a credit of nine months that undivided moiety of the Mill seat and a portion
 of land which Doctor David Newson did buy and possess, whereof Mark &
 James became the purchasers of said land for the sum of fifty dollars, and James B
 Brown became the purchaser of the interest in said Mill, which is one half for the sum of four hundred
 dollars. We then applied to sell to cash by the terms of sale which took place on the 26th
 day of December 1820 which would have become due the 26th Sept. last. after Mr. Brown failed
 to comply with the terms of sale we the Comptrolers exposed the said Mill seat to public sale
 the second time on the 3rd day of the present month (Oct.) whereof Benjamin Williams
 and John & Peron became the purchasers for the sum of two hundred & twenty dollars &
 twenty cents which became due the 3rd day of July 1821 leaving a deficiency of one
 hundred & sixty nine dollars & 76/100. We have taken their bond for the two hundred &
 twenty dollars & 25/100 - We received out of the sale of the land the sum of five dollars and as
 compensation for our services, leaving a balance of forty dollars which we have taken from
 James' Bond for with security which we humbly submit to the Court. Given under our
 hands this 18th day of October 1821 At Harris St. Francis Room."

Ordered that the debt shown to David Newson who is appointed receiver of the land returned
 by the Comptrolers caused by Mark & James & John Gray for the sum of fifty dollars
 due the 26th September 1821 that the said Newson collect the land and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that the bond be returned till the first day of the next Term
