The Commissioners in this cause this day read the report which in these words read,
"Pursuant to the award done in the undersigned Commissioners having sold to the highest
bidder on a credit of nine months that undivided moiety of the mill seat and a portion
of land which Doctor David Newson did buy and proposed, whereof Mark A.
James became the purchaser of said land for the sum of fifty dollars, and Isaac B.
Blair became the purchaser of the interest in said mill, which is one half for the sum of four hundred
dollars. Mr. Blair then applied to fulfil to comply with the terms of sale which took place on the 28th
day of December 1820 which would have become due the 28th Sept. last. after Mr. Blair failed
to comply with the terms of sale in the Commissioners exposed the said mill seat to public sale
the second time, on the 3rd day of the present month (Oct.) whereof Benjamin Williamson
and John & Person became the purchasers for the sum of two hundred & twenty dollars &
twenty cents which becomes due the 3rd day of July 1821 leaving a deficiency of one
hundred & sixty nine dollars & 75/100. We have taken their bond for the two hundred &
thirty dollars & 25/100 - We received out of the sale of the land the sum of five dollars and as
compensation for our services, leaving a balance of forty dollars which we have taken said
James Bond for with security which we finally returned to this Court. Given under our
hands this 18th day of October 1821 At Harris & Francis Remov."

Ordered that the debt due to David Newson who is appointed receiver the land returned
by the Commissioners executed by Mark A. James & John & Person for the sum of fifty dollars
due 26th September 1821 that the said Newson collect the land and make report thereof to Court.

Ordered that the land be returned till the first day of the next Term
