

Deed of Trust between James James of the first part James D Westbrook of the second part and Clark et al of the third conveying 8 beds and furniture and all the balance of his the said James James' household and kitchen furniture, stock of horses, hogs, cattle and other personal estate was proved in the Office on the 29th day of October 1841 by one of the witnesses thereto and having been before proved on the 28th day of October 1841 by two other witnesses thereto was admitted to record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Nathaniel Haines to Henry Moore conveying all his interest in a tract of land containing 342 acres and one acre Division was proved on the 29th day of October 1841 and having been before proved in the Office on 28th day of October 1841 by two other witnesses thereto was admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Tyler Edwards attorney in fact for Martha M. Muller to John B Jenkins conveying a tract of land containing 18 1/2 acres was acknowledged in the Office on the 29th day of October 1841 by Tyler Edwards and admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between William Edwards of the first part Benjamin Dornus of the second part and Spikes Beale of the third part conveying one bed and furniture, and all his the said Edwards' stock of hogs, crop of corn and all the balance of his property of what nature or kind soever was acknowledged in the Office on the 29th day of October 1841 by Edwards and Beale two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of bargain and sale from Jonas Edwards and Martha his wife to Spikes Beale conveying all his interest in a tract of land and slaves now held by Nancy Edwards as dower in the estate of Alford Edwards dec^d and also his interest in Elizabeth Williams' estate was acknowledged in the Office on the 29th of October 1841 by Jonas Edwards and together with the certificate of the jury examination and acknowledgment of the wife admitted to record.

Deed of Trust between William T Overett of the first part Sufe Drenow of the second part and Samuel Drenow and others of the third part conveying all the said Overett's life estate his may be as is entitled to in a contract between the said Overett and his wife Rebecca consisting of land, negroes, stock of all kinds all his the said Overett's crop of corn &c household and kitchen furniture was acknowledged in the Office on the 30th day of October 1841 by Overett & Drenow two of the parties thereto and admitted to Record.

Deed of Release from Sufe Lankford and Alfred T Nalley to Richard Beale releasing a tract of land containing 83 acres was acknowledged in the Office on the 31st November 1841 by Alfred T Nalley one of the parties thereto and having been before acknowledged in the Office on the 28th of October 1841 by Sufe Lankford another party thereto was admitted to Record.

A Power of Attorney from Alfred T Nalley administrator of James Scott dec^d to Robert Murray & Edwards Watts was acknowledged in the Office on the 31st November 1841 and admitted to Record.

The account current and Comptroller's report of Sufe T Parkman's administration on Erum Woodards estate having been in form and no exceptions and no exceptions being filed thereto was confirmed and ordered to be recorded.

The account current and Comptroller's report of William Jenkins' administration
