One to the grant children of Benjamin W. Johnson in their own right. One to the children of William Johnson in their own right. One to the children of James Johnson in their own right. One to the children of Collin Johnson in their own right. One to the children of Floris in their own right. And the other the Commissioner is authorized to return in his own right.
