That after advertising the time and place of sale, at the front door of the Courthouse on some Court day and at three or more public places in the County forty days before the sale at public auction to the highest bidder on a credit of nine months, the negro slaves the property of Lucy Dawson dec'd that he take seven bonds of equal amounts, and assign me to Sarah Gilliam in her own right. One to the grand children of Benjamin H. Johnson in their own right. One to the children of William Johnson in their own right. One to the children of James Johnson in their own right. One to the children of Oliver Johnson in their own right. One to the children of Florida in their own right. And the other the Commissioner is authorized to retain in his own right. And it is further more ordered and decreed, that if any of the above named legatees shall fail to appear and prove their identity within twelve months, that then she Commissioner shall deposit with the Clerk in the Clerks Office the bond or bonds to which such documents shall be established subject to the further order of this Court. And it is further ordered and decreed that the Commissioner shall make a general report of his actions to the Court in order to a final decree.
